

Discipline Policy

Every camper has his or her shortcomings. Our goal is to teach personal responsibility by discipline through the reality of consequences.

If a camper is disobedient, disrespectful or otherwise unruly the camper will be given a time-out, and the following steps will be taken:

First Warning: The camper will be spoken by the counselor in charge and will need to sit out of the activity for 10 minutes.

Second Warning: The camper will be spoken to by "the director in charge", and an additional activity will be missed.

Third Warning: We will contact the parent to speak with their camper to try and resolve the problem.

Fourth Warning: The parent will be notified to come and pick their camper up. It may also be recommended that the camper not return to camp the next day depending on the offense that the camper had to leave.

If the child receives three or more warnings on two (2) different days in the course of the summer, his parents will be handed a letter of probation. After the letter is given and the camper has another day in which he receives three or more warnings during the probationary period, the child will be unable to return to Valley Forge Day Camp for the remainder of the summer.
